GUIDELINES FOR SYNOPSIS AND THESIS

1. The title and the synopsis of the Thesis shall be approved by DRC & the Dean and principal. The same has to be submitted online, to OUHS within 3 months of admission to PG Course.
2. The University will get it evaluated and send the approval at the earliest with three types of observation:
 - a) Accepted
 - b) Accepted with suggestion for modification
 - c) Not accepted
3. Where the synopsis is not accepted, the student will resubmit the new proposal within one month of receipt of letter. The synopsis will be reevaluated and returned with observation. All this process will be completed within 6 months of admission. If non submission / non approval of synopsis exceeds 6 months, the student has to repeat for 6 months.
4. The Thesis work has to start by the end of 1st Semester with an aim to complete the thesis work by the end of 4th semester (students' period 18 months) and finally thesis will be submitted (both online & offline) to the University, 6 months prior to final University examination.
5. The Thesis work will be reviewed quarterly by the guide & at the end of 2nd 3rd and 4th semester by the HOD.
 - a) Thesis evaluator (one internal and two externals) will not be theory, practical and clinical examiners during final examination.
 - b) A list of examiners will be available at University level and the University will choose the thesis evaluator.
 - C) The synopsis submission fees will be Rs. 1500 per synopsis and thesis submission fees will be Rs. 5000/- per thesis.
